

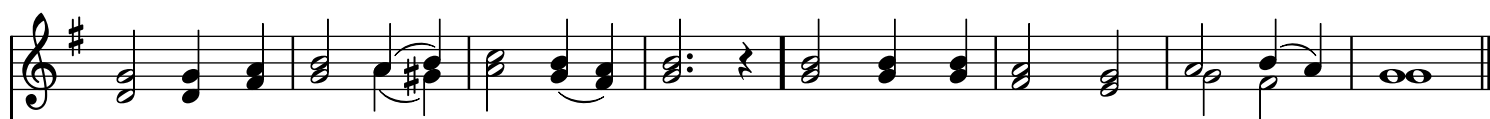
# On Calvary's Cross, Behold the One
