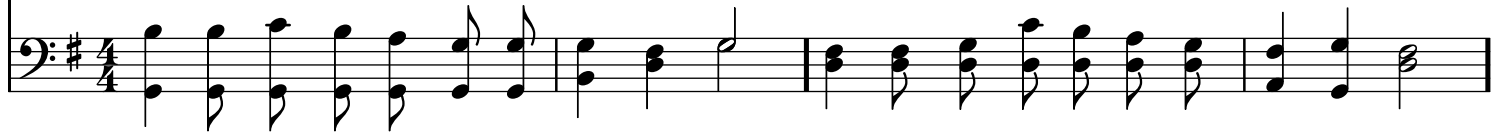




1. Oh, what a Saviour that He died for me! From con-dem-na-tion He hath made me free;
