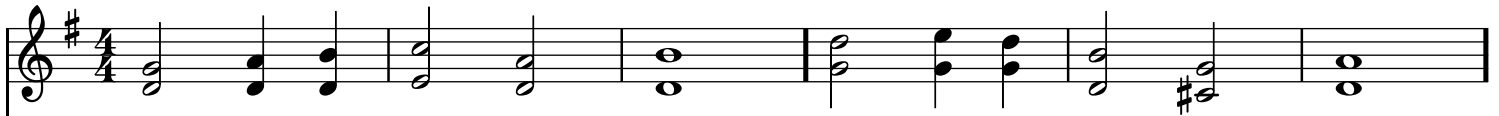


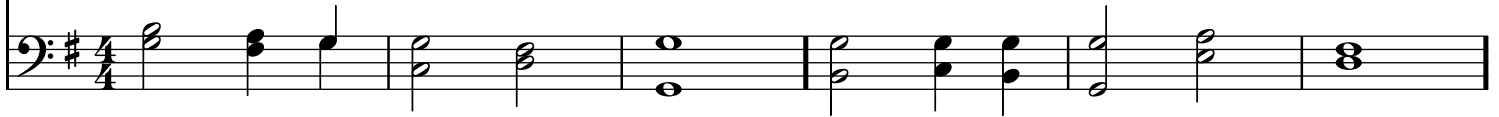
## Vain Is the Thought of Man
