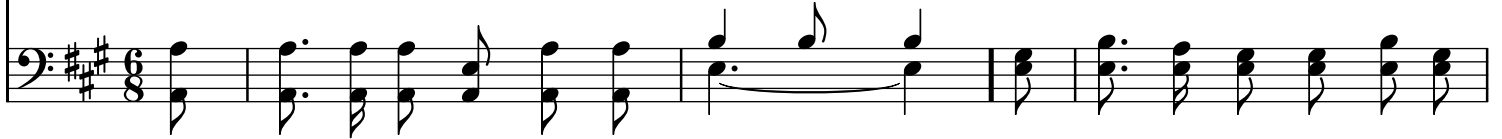




1. There comes to my heart one sweet strain, (sweet strain,) A glad and a joy - ous re -
