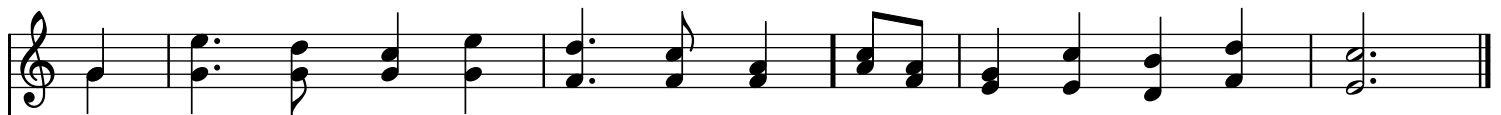


1. The Lord at-tends when chil - dren pray, A whis - per He can hear;
